THE MUST COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP FUND FOR UNDERPRIVILEGED STUDENTS

At its 63rd meeting, the MUST Council put in place a scholarship fund that provides needy but academically outstanding and privately sponsored students with assistance and contributions to their tuition fees, allowing them to pursue their studies with minimal burden and distraction.

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for the MUST Council Scholarship Fund for underprivileged students.

1. Eligibility criteria

Students applying for the scholarship must;

- be East Africans, under the age of 25 and fully registered at Mbarara University of Science and Technology,
- be on private sponsorship with no existing scholarship grants or Government scholarships to any Public University
- have completed their first year of study,
- be the best needy privately sponsored students from their faculty with a CGPA of not less than 3.6 at the time of applying,
- be in good standing at the time of application,
- not be gainfully employed,
- not have a retake in any paper at the time of applying for the scholarship,
- all applications shall be **ONLINE** and shall adhere to the deadline stipulated.
